STORY WRITING RUBRIC

Everything you need to know when we are viewing your manga.

So you want to become a manga-ka. Well there are some things, and or requirement must meet before being accepted into the P2 Manga company. Sorry we couldn't continue with the evaluations, but perhaps when we grow as a company we will hire people that will attend to such matters. So now to help you grow as an artist we at P2 will compile a list that you guys will follow to make sure your stories are intact. **SURPRISE!!**

ARTISTIC ABILITY:

- Artist uses their chosen medium in an outstanding way (*whether it be inking, toning, coloring, etc*)
- Artist displays impressive knowledge of technical skill (perspective, lighting, expressions, etc)
- Characters have appropriate designs for setting / genre, Character designs are distinct and creative (if it is a futuristic story you shouldn't have attire from the feudal japan *snickers* XD)

STORYLINE:

- Story must be creative. P2 judge on unique stories not stories that you have seen on television or by your favorite anime artist.
- Story is very clear and goals are met when designing the story (i.e. where you want the story to take place, what happens after your character fines her first love. Does she confess to him or does she admire him from afar until her friends push her up to it.)
- Well written, Good flow, Coherent, Interesting, "Hooks" the reader. Story has a natural flow to the dialogue, Story makes sense in context of the story, Used appropriately to move the story forward.
- It's okay to have some predictable elements in stories as long as they are ***not*** cliché.

CHARACTERS:

- Characters should reflect you. If you have to practice concept art every day, do it the more you practice the more you see a change in your art.

- Characters possess unique and distinct personalities, Easy to relate to, Reader cares what happens to them good or bad.
- Never mimic your favorite artist style. It shows respect for the artist that you admire by honoring their style but shows a great weakness when you can't come up with your own style and you mimic your favorite artist.

GRAMMAR:

- We publish our comics in English. If English is not your first language, its best to hire a proofreader or get someone close to you to translate it. If English is your first language, proofread your work and make sure that you have no spelling errors and no grammar errors (*I'll will make sure it will never happen again*)

Some good advice is to ask people who are not friends and family. People who are close to you are usually the ones that aren't honest and sugar coat things. It's okay to ask family and friends but ask them to be honest. Ask them where you lack and what you can do to become better. As long as you follow these guidelines you will have no problems being accepted into P2.
